We are pleased to announce the 140 Years Korean-German Partnerships Conference, coinciding with the 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of Korea-Germany diplomatic ties, will take place on September 19, 2023 (Tuesday) in Seoul.

Established in 2006 with the support of the German Embassy,
ADeKo (Alumninetzwerk Deutschland-Korea; Alumni Network Germany-Korea) is a
registered non-profit corporation under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

It was founded with the aim of expanding mutual understanding and collaboration between
Korea and Germany by enhancing cooperation and contributing to the
substantive development of both societies. ADeKo primarily focuses on over 20,000
Korean alumni who have studied in Germany, and it also opens its doors to the
approximately 110,000 employees of the 540 German companies operating in Korea
